Phase two will start from 1 October 2021 and will allow vaccinated travellers to enter Mauritius without restrictions upon presentation of a negative PCR test taken within 72 hours before departure.

**Those seeking an off-grid paradise can enjoy a complimentary day trip to the idyllic private island, Ile Des Deux Cocos, for bookings confirmed before 30 September 2021.** Guests staying between 1 October and 31 December 2021 can spend a day snorkelling in a protected marine reserve at Ile Des Deux Cocos, followed by a beach barbecue with freshly caught seafood. Sip on homemade infused rum cocktails and explore The Villa, the islet's historical landmark once home to the British governor, Sir Kesketh Bell, built in the 1920s.
